Day Walks - Only one has been included above but it is certain additional ones will be inserted, as are desired.

Private Trips - Originality and independence mark the higher attainments of bushwalking and the club wants to foster any private enterprise especially when this is carried on in areas not generally visited.

Huts and Tracks - At various stages of the year it is intended, having gailed permission, to construct at least one hut and one track in chosen areas on, or adjacent to, Brisbane "Scenic Rim".

The first such will be held on 14th March and it is expected some advice on bushwalking technique and equipment will be handed out.
